

Publishing and Maintaining the Business Interests Register of your Governing Body

GUIDANCE NOTES

Statutory Requirements for Maintained Schools

Schools must maintain a register of business interests and include all governors. In this regard, each governor should provide any in year updates that must be communicated to the clerk as soon as is reasonable. Clerks should ensure that there is a system in place that allows governors to make declarations whenever their interests and circumstances change.

A conflict of interest can arise when an individual's personal, business or family interests conflict with those of the school. A governor is required to declare any business, personal or other interest that we have in connection with the Governing body or the school in general for recording in the register of business interests including the following:

- links with individuals, businesses, contractors etc;
- directorships, shareholdings or other appointments where the school may purchase goods or services from or who are directly employed by the school, or
- interests of related persons such as parent, spouse, co-habitee, child or business partners where influence could be exerted by that person over a governor or a member of staff.

A register of business interests template is on the reverse side that you can use as a template for publication on the school's website.

From 1 September 2015, governing bodies will be under a duty to publish on their website their register of interests. The register should set out the relevant business interests of governors and details of any other educational establishments they govern. The register should also set out any relationships between governors and members of the school staff including spouses, partners and relatives. Academies

There is a requirement in the Articles of Association of Academies for governors who have a personal interest (financial or otherwise) which may conflict with their duties as governors to declare it as soon as they become aware of it.

Declarations should include the following:

- links with individuals, businesses, contractors etc;
- directorships, shareholdings or other appointments where the school may purchase goods or services from or who are directly employed by the school;
- interests of related persons such as parent, spouse, co-habitee, child or business partners where influence could be exerted by that person over a governor or a member of staff.

The latest edition of the Academies Financial Handbook requires academies to publish the register. Trusts must also publish on their websites relevant business and pecuniary interests of trustees and members.
