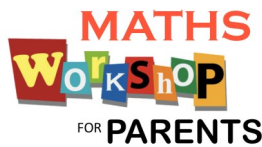
Y1 phonics screening takes place during the w/c June 12th

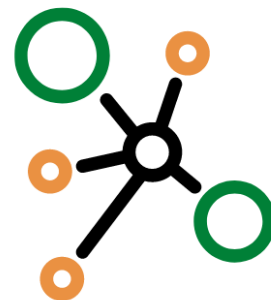
