Just before communion the priest will invite those about to receive the Eucharist to join him in prayer. He will say, 'Blest are those called to the supper of the lamb.' your child should respond with the congregation saying, 'Lord, I am not worthy that I should enter under your roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.'

This is a very special part in the mass where your child will receive the Eucharist for the first time. Your child will approach the altar and gently bow before kneeling with their hands joined. The priest will offer the host and say, 'The Body of Christ.' Your child will respond by saying, 'Amen' which means 'Indeed it is.' After this, your child must open their mouth and stick their tongue out. They must not take the host out of their mouth. They should return to their bench and kneel. This is a special moment where they should talk to God through prayer. It is a good idea that they learn this: 'Jesus I love you, Jesus I adore you, Jesus guide me, help me and give me strength.' After this, I always ask children to say thank you to God for three good things in their life and to ask for help with three things.


